The \$500.00 deposit cannot be deferred using Financial Aid or Installment Payment Plan.
2. This is an estimate of **minimum** out-of-pocket expenses. The estimate does not include personal entertainment, independent travel abroad or fluctuations in exchange rates.
3. Students in this program are required to purchase a Canadian health insurance policy.
