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#### PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

1. The **TOTAL PREPAID COSTS** is due to International Programs by May 1st. You may defer paying the balance of the prepaid cost, minus the \$500.00 deposit, using Financial Aid or sign up for the Installment Payment Plan. The \$500.00 deposit can not be deferred using Financial Aid or Installment Payment Plan.
2. This is an estimate of **minimum** out-of-pocket expenses. The estimate does not include personal entertainment, independent travel abroad or fluctuations in exchange rates.
3. Students living with a host family will pay CSU IP for their housing and some meals (and public transportation) as a prepaid cost. The host family cost due to CSU IP prior to departure is \$8,800 (\$8,000 US for housing + \$800 for public transportation). Students should budget an additional \$3,000 out of pocket expense for additional meals not provided by the host family.
4. You will be asked to enter the **TOTAL ESTIMATED PROGRAM COST** amount on the Financial Data questionnaire.
