## PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

- 2. This is an estimate of *minimum* out-of-pocket expenses. The estimate does not include personal entertainment, independent travel abroad or fluctuations in exchange rates.
- 3. Students should expect to spend up to \$1,500 on arrival for housing, utilities, textbooks, etc.
