

Required Courses and Units for CSU IP Participants for 2024-25 and 2025

CSU students accepted to the CSU International Programs are required to take various courses as indicated in the table below.

Required courses and units are organized by semester, country, study center and academic track (study area).

Required language courses may constitute one or more courses which must be taken in the term under which the requirement appears.

All students are required to take an equivalent minimum of 15 CSU semester units each semester unless stated otherwise in the Academic Bulletin.

Semester only programs are not available at all study centers. Where semester programs are available, semester students will be required to take courses as listed in the table below.
