- (d) San José campus- Engineering students are required to have a minimum 80 TOEFL iBT or 7.0 IELTS test scores.
- (e) Students who study for one calendar year from January to December should demonstrate financial amounts in excess of those listed in the table above (due to inflation and to cover the summer period).
- (f) Students who study for one calendar year from January to December who live on-campus and who plan to stay in California during the summer may be required to leave on-campus housing and find other housing.

Additional Comments:

- (1) Information on this page including campus costs, campus health insurance requirements, health insurance costs and health insurance providers used is subject to change. Costs may be higher than listed.
- (2) As part of the application process, exchange students are required to furnish verification of finances for the amount listed for the campus (or campuses) that they have listed on their application.
- (3) All students are required to purchase health insurance that covers the exchange period. Most campuses require that students purchase their health insurance regardless of whether the student has health insurance from their home country.
- (4) Campus-based fees are not covered by the exchange agreement and are subject to change (or added where not indicated). Fees are due upon invoice. Nonpayment of fees by the deadline date can result in disenrollment in classes, registration holds, non-release of the final transcript and/or dismissal from exchange.
- (5) In addition to campus-based fees (where listed), students may incur course fees that are not covered by exchange (for course supplies, lab fees or field trips).
- (6) Fresno campus- The cost of health insurance is different for each term. The full 2024-25 Academic year is \$1,700
- (7) Los Angeles campus- The cost of health insurance is different for each term. Fall semester is \$657 and Spring semester is \$918. Annual (2 semesters) total is \$1575.
- (8) San Bernardino campus- The cost of health insurance is different for each term. Fall semester is \$1,005 and Spring semester is \$1,407 Annual total is \$2,412 (subject to change).
- (9) San José campus- The cost of health insurance is different for each term. Fall semester is \$795 and Spring semester is \$1095.
- (10) San Luis Obispo campus- The cost of health insurance is different for each term. The amount for each quarter is \$516.
- (11) Graduate students are normally required to have a minimum score of 80 TOEFL iBT or 7.0 IELTS although some programs may require higher scores.
