

CSU Campus Impacted and Restricted Subject Areas for 2024-25

Campuses must **not** be listed on an application if the subject area is listed in the “Impacted (Closed) Subject Area” column. Campuses accept a limited number of applications in certain fields, which are listed below under “Restricted Subject Areas” as offerings can be limited. Applicants who are selected to attend a campus where there are impacted/closed courses disciplines will not be permitted to enroll in courses from those impacted/closed disciplines. Students should only list courses in which prerequisites have been met. Courses labeled under “Extended Education”, Certificate and Credential Programs are closed to exchange students regardless of the campus. The list below is subject to change without notice.
