

California State University Housing Information

Each CSU campus has their own housing office which provides information about the housing options for new students. On-campus housing options are available but may be limited at some campuses and on-campus housing is not guaranteed. Dormitories typically house first-year university students, ages 18-20, and are co-ed, with floors reserved for female students and other floors reserved for male students. It is typical for university students to share a bedroom with another student which saves on costs. In many dorms, there is a bathroom in the hall with 3 or 4 showers, sinks and toilets, which is shared by 10-12 students.

Many international students decide to live in off-campus apartments near the university. This usually entails arriving a couple of weeks before classes start to allow time to find housing. More detailed information about housing will be provided by your host CSU campus prior to your arrival and is available on campus housing websites.
